Tender Hearts Ladies Luncheon to feature June Hunt

Dallas, TX - January 12, 2009. The third-annual Tender Hearts Ladies Luncheon, benefiting Need Him Ministries, will be held at noon on Friday, February 13, 2009, in the Garden Court at Hotel Intercontinental, Dallas. More than 350 women throughout the North Dallas/Collin County community are expected to attend this year's luncheon. The event is especially geared to minister to the mind, body, and spirit for heart-healthy women.

June Hunt will be our keynote speaker. June is a dynamic Christian leader whose life work has yielded landmark contributions in the field of Christian counseling. Early family pain was the catalyst that shaped June's compassionate heart. Later, as a youth director, she became aware of the need for sound biblical counsel. This led June to a lifelong commitment to providing *God's Truth for Today's Problems*. After years of teaching and research, she developed *Counseling Through The Bible*, a scripturally-based counseling course addressing approximately 100 topics, such as marriage and parenting, depression and anger, stress and suicide. An author, singer and speaker, she founded *Hope for the Heart Ministries* in 1986. Since then, the ministry has offered hope and help through biblically-based counsel and encouragement to people in more than 60 countries. Whether writing, speaking or singing, June is dedicated to presenting *God's Truth for Today's Problems*. Through her life-transforming approach (inspired by Romans 12:2), she readily shares the truth that a *changed mind* produces a *changed heart ...* and a *changed heart* produces a *changed life*.

Special music for the day will be provided by 14-year-old recording artist Natalie Rose from San Antonio, TX. Natalie recorded her first single when she was only 4-years-old. Her song "Two Hearts" is currently listed at #46 on the Country Gospel charts. In 2008, Natalie opened for Ronnie Milsap and for Ray Price. This year she is scheduled to open Charlie Pride's concerts.

The luncheon will offer attendees opportunities to support the ministry through a Silent Auction and "Dot's Boutique," a small cash-and-carry area at the luncheon.
